GOLF COURSE UPDATES

Course improvements are being considered to enhance the playing experience at MLCC. The board is reviewing plans for the #16 tee box expansion, with private donations being pursued to fund the project. In addition, rock will be added around cart paths, and several trees near holes #6, #15, and the lake on #16 are scheduled for removal this summer to improve safety, aesthetics, and course maintenance. As a friendly reminder to all golfers, please sign in at the Pro Shop during open hours or at the Bar if the Pro Shop is closed. Also, repair your ball marks on the greens and keep golf carts at least 30 feet away from tees and greens to help preserve course conditions.



POOL NEWS

The pool season is off to a great start! Memorial Day weekend was a success, and we want to give a big thank you to Greg, the lifeguards and Pool Committee for hitting the ground running. The flow and chlorinator systems are working well, though still being finetuned for peak performance. Looking ahead, we plan to replace the piping between the pit and pumps immediately after the season wraps up. As a reminder to parents, please pick up after your children — several items of clothing and trash were left behind last

weekend. Let's work together to keep the pool, tennis courts and picnic table areas clean and enjoyable for everyone.

Around the grounds, several updates and reminders are in motion. Please remember that children must be at least 12 years old to be at the lake without a parent. On Tuesdays and Thursdays, which are heavy golf days, fishing is limited to the northside (by the picnic table) or the east side (along the dam) for everyone's safety. We're also reviewing electrical loads in the golf cart sheds to ensure safety and efficiency. We are still looking for a handyman for small projects at a rate of \$25/hour — please reach out if you're interested or know someone who may be. In the Pro Shop, we're exploring cooling solutions as the current vent is blocked by the cooler. Lastly, the tennis courts will receive an upgrade with new LED lighting and a timer system to improve evening play.
